Madara Silina (27), beautician

- When did you start your company? And how long is it?
- It is a small company which has just opened. I started it only 4 months ago.
- Who helped you with starting it?
- The idea was mine. But without my family's support I was not able to start it.
- How big is your company? How many people are in it now?
- As I told the company has just started its works, and it means that at the moment it is very small. The only worker in the beauty salon is me. But of course I need the help with accounting.



- Are you planning your company's growth?
- At the moment I am not planning it. For me much more important is to wider the sortiment services which I offer to my

costomers.

- What education have you got?
- I have finished different courses as beautician and I have got the highest level in it. But at the moment I am studying medicine too.
- Why did you choose to work in the industry of a beauty?
- I decided to be a beautician when I was 18 and then I started to learn
 - about it. I worked in a very big company in London for about 6 years. And then I understood that I would like to get my own company. That is how do I started it.
- What are good and bad things about having your own company?
- The positive aspect is that you could organise your time how would you like. Of course, you must think about your customers and do the best for them, but if you need to take a break you can organise it by yourself.

The worst is that you are responsible for everything. I have not got any help in my everyday work. And if there is any fault, I will be liable for it.



- Did you face to any difficulties in your business?
 - At the moment there are not any difficulties.
- When do you start your working day and how long is it? Do you work at the weekends too?
- It depends how many customers I have got. Sometimes I start at 7.30 a.m. and finish at 8.30 p.m. But there are days when I start only in the midday and finish before 5.00 p.m. And I work on Saturdays too. Many of my customers are busy during the week and it is easier for them to get on Saturdays. But Sundays are always free.
 - What do you do in your free time?
 - I really like theatre and ballet and I go to

watch a play or performance every month. Quite often I go to the cinema. And I like to go back to London and visit the places where I was when I lived there.

- What do you recommend to people who would like to start their own business?
- At first you must be sure that the business which you are planning to start is necessary to people. Then you have to make your long-lasting business plan. And only if you are sure about it on 100% that it will work, start it! If you have any doubts, do not do it!




Ivars Marašinskis (54), the owner of LRC "Kandavas celi"
