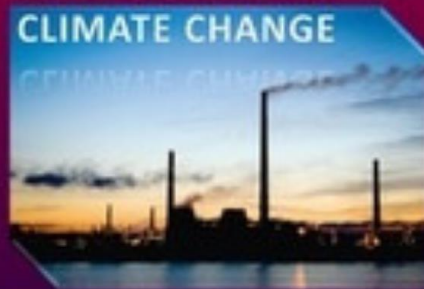


Cause – too many cars, too much smoke coming from factories.

Solution: get rid of your waste in special andreccling contciners and bins, mechanicly and biologicly clean the water, don't use fertilizer

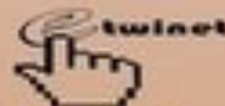
